IX. Open Enrollment Approvals / Denials for 2018-19

Annual acceptance or denial of open enrollment applications.

Starting with the 2016-17 school year, resident districts will no longer be able to deny a pupil's open enrollment for undue financial burden or based on the pupil's eligibility for or need of a reasonable accommodation in a Section 504 plan. An application may only be denied if there is no space in the special education or related services required in the pupil's IEP or if the special education or related services are not available.

For incoming students, applications may be denied for students with an expulsion on their record, or for grade levels or programs that do not have space. As far as space, the District set no seat limits.

Since the number of applications is lower than the available seats for all grade levels and there are no expelled students, all applications should be approved.
