

COPYRIGHT COMPLIANCE

It is the intent of the Board to delineate, enforce, and abide by the provisions of current copyright laws as they affect the District and its employees.

Copyright materials, whether they are print or non-print, will not be duplicated unless such reproduction meets “fair use” standards, or unless written permission from the copyright holder has been received.

Details about “fair use” are available to all teachers. A summary of these standards is contained in the District’s IMC Curriculum Guide and is available from each school’s IMC Director.

The Board does not sanction illegal duplication in any form. Employees who willfully disregard the District’s copyright position are in violation of Board policy; they do so at their own risk and assume all liability.

There shall be no copying of or from works intended to be “consumable” in the course of study or of teaching. These include workbooks, exercises, standardized tests and test booklets and answer sheets and like consumable material.

Videos used solely for entertainment purposes may not be shown to classroom groups, as this is a violation of copyright law. Classroom videos must serve an educational purpose tied to the curriculum.
