

TITLE I PROGRAM

In order to meet its goal of providing educational opportunities for all students of the School District of Brodhead, the Board of Education shall participate in the Federal Title I program.

The District has met the criteria to establish a school wide Title I services model that includes all children enrolled in Kindergarten through Grade 5 at Albrecht Elementary School. All staff, resources, and classes serving Kindergarten through Grade 5 students are considered a part of the school-wide team supporting high levels of academic achievement.

The District is committed to providing high quality instruction supported by professional development that focuses on strategies and methods grounded in scientifically based research. The District will, therefore, establish an annual continuous improvement process. This jointly developed planning will communicate next steps based on disaggregated achievement data, a review of current practice, and analysis of current research, as well as input from families and community members.

The Board recognizes the importance of a strong partnership between school personnel and the families of Title I students in supporting student achievement, especially for students most at risk of not meeting high academic standards. To strengthen this partnership, the District will provide appropriate opportunities for parents and family members of Title I students to become involved in the design and implementation of the Title I program.

The School District shall not discriminate on the basis of any protected category under State or Federal law.
