

ALTERNATIVE OR EXTENDED INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

Students who fall behind in credits at Brodhead High School will be allowed to receive make-up credits from other approved institutions. The courses chosen, and credits to be granted for successful completion, must be approved in advance by the Building Principal. The cost is to be paid by the student, unless other arrangements are approved by the Building Principal and Superintendent.

Students who are identified as Children At-Risk (per policy JDLB) may be offered alternative or extended programs. The cost of these programs will be negotiated with the student and his/her parents/guardians and may be covered partially or fully by the District with the approval of the superintendent.

With prior approval from the principal, Juniors and Seniors may take courses at other institutions for credit toward graduation at Brodhead High School. Again, the level of credit to be granted must be approved in advance by the Building Principal.

The School District shall not discriminate on the basis of any protected category under Wisconsin or Federal Statute.
