Instructional and reference media (books, recordings, etc.) donated to the Brodhead Public Schools as gifts are subject to discretionary use as recommended by the staff and approved by the Building Principal.

Supplementary materials from commercial, political, religious, or other non-school sources are subject to the same review given any other material.

Approval may be given to materials which are of obvious educational quality, which supplement and enrich text and reference book materials for definite school courses, which are timely and up-to-date, and which promote American democratic ideals and moral values, yet recognize the pluralistic nature of the American society.

No materials may be accepted which do not meet the selection standards of the schools and which would not ordinarily be approved for purchase were funds available.

The School District shall not discriminate on the basis of any protected category under Wisconsin or Federal Statute.
