

NON-DISCRIMINATION

It is the policy of the District that no person may be illegally discriminated against in employment by reason of any protected category under State or Federal law.

Non-discrimination information shall be printed in the job applications and employee handbooks, and shall be published annually in August in the local newspaper to make parents, community members and employees aware of their rights.

Any individual believing that the School District of Brodhead or any part of the school organization has inadequately applied the non-discrimination policy and discriminated against the individual may file a complaint with the Superintendent of the School District of Brodhead, 2501 W. Fifth Avenue, Brodhead, WI 53520, (608-897-2141). Complaint procedures may be found in policy ACA.
