

SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

A Special School Board meeting shall be held upon the written request of any Board member duly filed with the District Clerk (or President, in the Clerk's absence). All members of the Board will be notified of the time and location of the Special Meeting at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting.

A Special School Board meeting may be held without prior notice, if all members are present and consent, or if every member consents in writing even though he/she does not attend. In no case shall a meeting be convened unless two hours' notice of the meeting is given.

Any legal meeting of the Board may be adjourned to a specific time and place.
