

NOTIFICATION OF BOARD MEETINGS

Public notice of each School Board meeting will be given. It is the responsibility of the School Board President (or his/her designee) to communicate notice of School Board meetings to the public, through media who have filed a written request to receive such notice and to the official newspaper designated under the provisions of Chapter 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The notice must give the time, date, place and subject matter of the meeting in a form which will adequately apprise members of the public and the media.

Notice may be posted in at least three prominent public places if it proves impossible or impractical to notify the media sufficiently in advance of a meeting. Notice should be given at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of a meeting, unless for good cause such notice is impossible or impractical, but in no case may less than a two-hour notice of the meeting be given.
