

POLICY REVIEW AND REVISION

Board policies will be subject to periodic review, and recommendations for revision by the Policy Committee.

All Board members and administrators should be alert to current and emerging issues which may necessitate a revision to Board policies. The Superintendent is charged with the responsibility of monitoring legislative actions that may require new Board policies, or revisions to existing policies.

The Policy Committee will meet at least once per year to examine policies containing specific review timelines, and to identify other policies that may be in need of review.

To ensure on-going periodic review, the general intent of the Board is to review the policy manual every three (3) years. The Board may review a section of the Policy Manual at the first regular Board meeting of each month. The policy section of the manual will be listed on the agenda, and each Board member will review that section prior to the meeting. Items of concern in that section may be brought forth for discussion at that time. Should changes be necessary, the School Board may approve them at that meeting and the recommended changes returned to the Board for consideration under its routine two-reading approval procedure.
