

WALKERS AND RIDERS

Transportation will be provided for all pupils who reside in the School District two miles or more from the nearest public school they are entitled to attend, or for nonresident students attending the School District of Brodhead under the Open Enrollment policy as outlined under policy EEAC. All students living outside the city limits will be provided transportation.

Students living less than two miles from the school they attend may be transported if they are subjected to an “unusual hazard” area while walking to school and are exempt from section (b) that follows.

- a. An “unusual hazard” exists for those students who are required to walk to school on a town road, county, State or Federal highway where there are no sidewalks and the speed limit is in excess of 25-miles per hour.
- b. Any student can be required to walk an “unusual hazard” area if such distance does not exceed .5-mile for 6-12 grade students.

Resident students attending private schools located within the District or up to five miles outside the District boundary lines shall be eligible for transportation privileges in the same manner as students attending the public school. The District recognizes its legal authority to provide an alternative transportation contract per State Statute where it is in the best interest of the District.
