

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

I. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS - CREDITS

The graduation requirements of the Brodhead School District are a combined total of twenty-five (25) credits in high school divided as follows:

- Four (4) credits of English                      One (1) credit at each level
- Three (3) credits of Social Studies            Social Studies 9, World History and U.S. History
- Two (3) credits of Mathematics
- Two (3) credits of Science
- One and one-half (1½) credits of Physical Education
- One-half (½) credit of Health
- One-half (½) credit of Vocational Education
- One-half (½) credit of personal finance

In addition to the required credits listed, students will take a minimum of ten and one-half (10½) elective credits to meet the twenty-five (25) credit graduation requirement. Students will be required to take a minimum load of seven (7) credits per year unless they are a senior on work-study.

A full credit (one) is earned by receiving a passing grade in a course offered every day, for one class period, for the full school year.

II. SENIOR PROJECT REQUIREMENT

All students are required to complete a senior project and have it successfully reviewed before they are eligible for graduation.

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III. TRANSFER STUDENTS

Transfer students shall have their credits evaluated by the high school principal, and may be allowed to graduate with a pro-rated number of credits reflecting an equivalent to Brodhead High School credit requirements.

IV. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to participate in the commencement ceremony, a student must have completed all credit requirements and the senior project requirement, paid all school fees (including cost of graduation materials), and made up all detention time owed. The student is responsible for ensuring all requirements are met.
