

EARLY GRADUATION

Early graduation is an option available for students at Broadhead High School. The following procedures will be used in the process for early graduation:

1. A completed application form will be submitted to the building principal prior to October 1st.
2. A review of all credit and subject completion requirements will be conducted by the principal and guidance counselor. The student must have met all requirements that existed when he/she entered Broadhead High School.
3. Completion of a senior project is required. The senior project must be completed and presented before receiving their diploma.
4. Following the graduation requirements review, the parent/guardian and student will be informed of the decision regarding early graduation status.
5. The diploma will be awarded at the regular graduation date for that school year. Early graduates have the right to participate in all regular graduation ceremonies and activities. Proof of completion of requirements will be provided for students requesting such verification.
6. Administrative decisions at any stage of the above process may be appealed to the Board of Education through the Superintendent of Schools.

The School District shall not discriminate on the basis of any protected category under Wisconsin or Federal Statute.
