

ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

1. Residents - All students whose parents or persons having legal custody residing within the limits of the School District of Brodhead shall attend school in the District without payment of tuition.
2. A child of nonresident parent(s) whose care, custody and support has been assigned to a resident of the District may attend school without payment of tuition, provided appropriate information has been filed with the District Office. In such cases, the reason for school attendance must be unrelated to any educational or co-curricular benefits that may be attained by attending a District School rather than a school in the child's resident District. Proof will be required that the child's residence in the District is for other than educational or co-curricular benefits.
3. Students entering the School District of Brodhead from other public schools, home based instructional programs, or private schools will be screened by the District to determine appropriate grade and/or program placement. The District will consider the student's mental, social, emotional and physical development before making a final determination on placement. The District may require testing deemed appropriate by the Administration to assist in this determination.

If the above screening should indicate a possible exceptional educational need the student will be referred for EEN evaluation.

4. Students entering Brodhead High School from another high school will have their transcripts and credits reviewed by the high school principal and/or guidance counselor to determine proper placement in classes. The high school principal will be responsible for establishing required course and credit needs for transfer students that will lead to a Brodhead High School Diploma.
5. The School District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity based on the basis of any protected category under state or federal law.
