

STUDENT ORGANIZATION FACILITIES USE

Access to school facilities by student groups, other than those sponsored by the school, is provided by federal law. Student organized groups must adhere to the following guidelines to make use of facilities.

1. The group must be organized by students, for students, and have a stated purpose.
2. Group meetings must take place at reasonable times for proper school supervision and security.
3. No individuals other than students or an assigned staff member may attend the group meetings on a regular basis.
4. Students must direct and organize the meetings, and may invite an individual(s) to a meeting.
5. School facilities will be used and taken care of properly by the group.
6. Application for recognition of a group and for use of the facility must be made to the building principal. The application must document that acceptable supervision will be provided.

The School District shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of any protected category under Wisconsin or Federal statutes.
