

IMMUNIZATION OF STUDENTS

1. Students attending schools in the School District of Brodhead must have received the minimum required immunizations for each age/grade level, within 30 days of admission, as outlined by the Wisconsin Student Immunization Law (except as noted in item (2b) below.

2. No student may be admitted to school unless:
 - a. An immunization history is provided to the school including the dates (month, day, year) of each dose received by the student. This record must indicate that the student meets the requirements for the grade level he/she is entering.

 - b. A waiver is provided to the school on a State of Wisconsin Student Immunization Record Form (provided by the school or physician's office) indicating one of the following:
 1. Health Reasons: The waiver form is completed and signed by a physician indicating the required immunization is, or may be, detrimental to the student's health. A history of all required immunizations that have been received shall be provided and kept on file.

 2. Religious Reasons: The waiver form is signed by the parent (or student if no longer a minor) that the student is an adherent to a religious belief that precludes immunization. A history of all required immunizations have been received shall be provided and kept on file.

 3. Personal Conviction Reasons: The waiver form is signed by a parent (or student if no longer a minor) indicating an objection to immunizations because of personal beliefs. A history of all required immunizations that have been received shall also be provided and kept on file.

3. A student whose immunization records are in the process of being transferred may attend classes for no longer than 30 days without submitting a record.
4. Students who are incompletely immunized and those with waivers may be excluded from school if an outbreak of a vaccine-preventable disease occurs.
5. The School District will report to the district attorney any students/families that are not in compliance with this policy sixty days after admission to the school.
6. Students not compliant with the immunization policy of the School District of Brodhead may be excluded from school at the discretion of the building principal in accordance with Wisconsin State Statute 252.04.
